One of the best ways to appreciate the sights, sounds and scents of Fiordland National Park's unique environment is on a bicycle. This tour suits all ages and abilities and allows you to take in the grandeur of your surroundings at your own pace.

The day starts with a two hour drive through rural Southland to the small township of Te Anau. We visit the bird sanctuary and drop into the Department of Conservation's Fiordland National Park HQ. After morning tea we continue along the road towards Milford Sound, avoiding the rush of tour coaches.

At Lake Gunn we mount our bikes for an easy ride around a quiet nature trail — a safe environment for you to familiarise yourself with the gears and brakes of your state-of-the-art mountain bikes.

We then drive on to the Divide before jumping onto the bikes for a downhill ride into the beautiful Hollyford Valley, finishing at Gunn's Camp.

We climb aboard our vehicle again, this time to disembark at the western entrance of the Homer Tunnel. From this point we bike downhill through spectacular scenery, alongside the banks of the Cleddau River until we arrive in Milford Sound itself.

Here we board a boat for a cruise around this 'Eighth Wonder of the World'. Afterwards, weather permitting, we take to the skies for a scenic flight high over the Darren Mountains and back to Queenstown.
